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POPULATION AND VITAL STATISTICS DECEMBER 2024

The estimated population of all residents (Seychellois and Non-Seychellois) stood at 122,036 at 31st December 2024, indicating a growth rate of 1.2% over same period of 2023. A total of 1,333 births and 850 deaths were registered in 2024. Of the 850 deaths, 17 were infant deaths and the infant mortality rate stood at 12.8 per thousand live births compared to 15.5 in 2023. The total fertility rate stands at 1.7 and the life expectancy for both sexes is 76.0 years.

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END OF YEAR POPULATION 2024

1. POPULATION CHANGE

Tables 1a and 1b show key demographic indicators for the period 1986-2024. Table 2a illustrates the components of population change for all resident population during the period 2010-2024, while Table 2b presents the components of population change for Seychellois residents only for the same period. The population of all residents (Seychellois and Non-Seychellois) is estimated at 122,038 persons. This represents an increase of 1,455 persons or an annual growth rate of 1.2% over 2023. The Seychellois only population is estimated at 101,093 as of 31st December 2024. This represents an increase of 491 persons, or an annual growth rate of 0.5% over 2023.

2. BIRTHS & FERTILITY

In 2024, there were 1,333 births registered, compared to 1,553 births in 2023. Of these, 682 were registered in the first six months, and 651 in the last six months of 2024. The crude birth rate, which measures the number of births per thousand mid-year population, was 11.0 in 2024, compared to 13.0 in 2023.

Table 3 provides information on the number of births by sex and status for the period 2019-2024, while Table 4a shows the number of births by birth order and by status and age group of mother for the year 2024 only. Table 4b shows births by district of residence and age group of mother for 2024.

Of the 1,333 births registered in 2024, 250 (19%) occurred within marriage, 897 (67%) were acknowledged, and 185 (14%) were natural. The percentage of legitimate births increased from 17% in 2023 to 19% in 2024. Meanwhile, the percentage of acknowledged births decreased from 69% in 2023 to 67% in 2024. The proportion of natural births, however, remain constant at 14% across both years. Additionally, one birth was recorded under the "Not Stated" category in 2024, which refers to an abandoned child.

Figure 1: Births by status, 2024

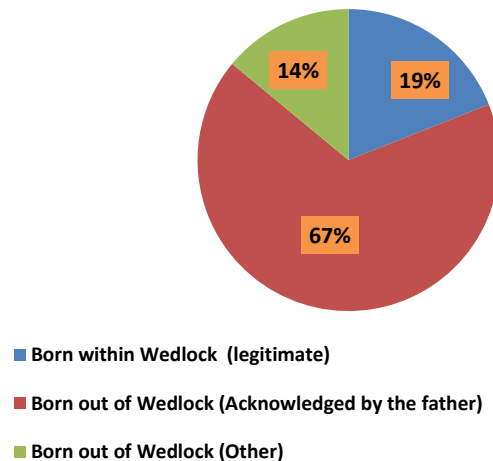


Table 4a shows that 172 (13%) of all births in 2024 occurred to women aged less than 20.

Figure 2: Births by age group of mother, 2023-2024

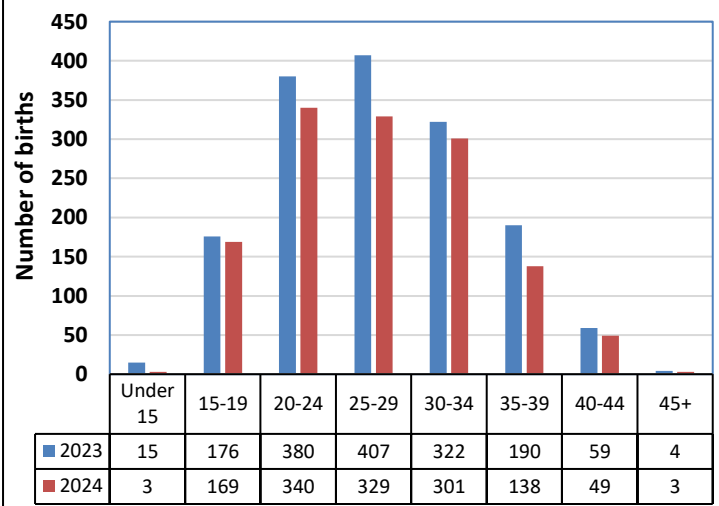


Table 4b shows that the districts with the highest number of births were Perseverance (84), Anse Etoile (77), Au Cap (71), and Anse aux Pins (67). Among the total number of births in each district, Mont Fleuri recorded the highest percentage of births to teenagers (32%), followed by Perseverance (24%), and Pointe Larue (22%).

Table 5a and Table 5b shows the age-specific fertility rates (ASFR) and total fertility rates (TFR) for all resident and Seychellois only for the period 2010 to 2024. The fertility rate is determined by the number of births in relation to the size and age structure of the female population.

In 2024, the Total Fertility Rate (TFR) for all resident population declined to 1.7, compared to 2.0 in 2023, reflecting a significant reduction in the average number of children a woman is expected to have throughout her lifetime. A similar trend was observed among Seychellois resident population, with the TFR dropping from 2.2 in 2023 to 1.85 in 2024.

Chart 5 shows the trend in teenage fertility from 1998-2024. Two versions of TFR are shown. One using actual births, and a simulation of what the TFR would look like if all reported pregnancies had ended up as live births.

The variation in the Total Fertility Rate (TFR) for the age group 15-19 is noticeably large. If those pregnancies had not been terminated, the TFR would have peaked at above 56 births per thousand women in 2024, compared to 45 when abortions are discounted.

Chart 6b shows the percentage distribution of births and abortions from 2005-2024. The trend for the last 19 years shows that on average, abortions account for one quarter of potential¹ live births.

3. DEATHS

There were 850 deaths registered in 2024, of which 18 occurred to non-residents (Table 6b). The crude death rate for the year was 7.0 per thousand mid-year population. (The number of deaths in Table 1a differs from that in Table 2a because deaths of persons who are not part of the all resident population are excluded from the calculation of the population estimates in Table 2a.) If the 18 deaths of non-residents were excluded, the crude death rate would decrease to 6.9. Table 9 provides details on age and sex-specific mortality rates for the period 2022-2024.

The total number of infant deaths (deaths to babies aged less than one year) for 2024 was 17. The infant mortality rate is 12.8 per thousand live births, compared to 15.5 in 2023.

Tables 8a and 8b shows the major causes of death for the period 2020-2024. Diseases of the circulatory system were the leading cause of death, contributing 29%, followed by neoplasms at 19%, and diseases of the respiratory system at 14%

Table 10 shows life expectancy at birth by sex for the years 1980-2024. The number of years a male is expected to live is 72.1 years and for female, it is 80.7 years.

4. MARRIAGES

There were 553 marriages registered in the first six months of 2024, of which 16 % were by residents. Tables 11a and 11b show marriages by age of bride and groom for residents and visitors combined, and for residents only, respectively. Tables 12a and 12b show marriages by age and previous marital status of bride and groom respectively, for residents only.

5. DIVORCES

There were 170 divorces registered in 2024 (Table 1a). Table 13 shows divorces by duration of marriage for the period 2010-2024.

6. CONCEPTS, SOURCES, METHODS AND DEFINITIONS

The end of year population estimate refers to the number of people in the population at 31st December each year, and the statistics are referred to as the end of year estimates. These estimates refer to the usual resident population which is based on the UN guidelines and are benchmarked to the results of the Population and Housing Census.

The end of year population estimates are updated by adding births and subtracting deaths. Explanatory notes are given below for each of the population components.

BIRTHS

Birth figures are obtained from the Civil Status office for all registered births. Births to non-Seychellois mothers are also included. There are 3 statuses of births, namely:

- (a) *Legitimate: -Births occurring within marriage*
- (b) *Acknowledged Births: Recognized by the father*
- (c) *Natural Births: Not recognized by the father*

DEATHS

Death figures are obtained from the Civil Status office for all registered deaths. Deaths to non-residents and deaths to babies who have not been registered as births are excluded in the end of year estimates calculation.

MARRIAGES

Marriage figures are obtained from the Civil Status office for all registered marriages. Marriages to non-residents are included.

DIVORCES

Divorce figures are obtained from the Civil Status office for all registered divorces.

MIGRATION

Migration is the geographic movement of people across a specified boundary for the purpose of establishing a new permanent or semi-permanent residence. The terms “immigration” and “emigration” are used to refer to movement between countries (international migration). Data on Migration is downloaded from the Immigration Information systems of the Immigration Division. Net migration is immigrants less emigrants.

8. DEMOGRAPHIC DEFINITIONS

Birth rate: The birth rate (also called the crude birth rate) indicates the number of live births per 1,000 population in a given year.

Death rate: The death rate (also called the crude death rate) indicates the number of deaths per 1,000 population in a given year.

Infant Mortality rate: The number of deaths of infants under age 1 per 1,000 live births.

Growth rate: The growth rate is the rate at which a population is increasing (or decreasing) in a given year due to:

(a) *natural increase and (b) net migration*

It is expressed as a percentage of the base population, and takes into account all components of population growth: **Births, Deaths and Migration**

Fertility rate: The total fertility rate (TFR) is the average number of children that would be born to a woman by the time she reaches the end of her childbearing years if she were to pass through all those years conforming to the age specific fertility rates of a given year. The TFR is one of the most useful indicators of fertility because it gives the best picture of how many children women are currently having. Fertility rates can also be calculated for specific age groups to see differences in fertility behavior or to make comparison over time.

Age Specific Death Rate: Death rates can be calculated for specific age groups in order to compare mortality at different ages or at the same age over time. Due to the sex and age variation in mortality, death rates are often presented separately for males and females.

Life expectancy: Life expectancy is an estimate of the average number of additional years a person is expected to live if the age specific death rates for a given year prevailed for the rest of his or her life.

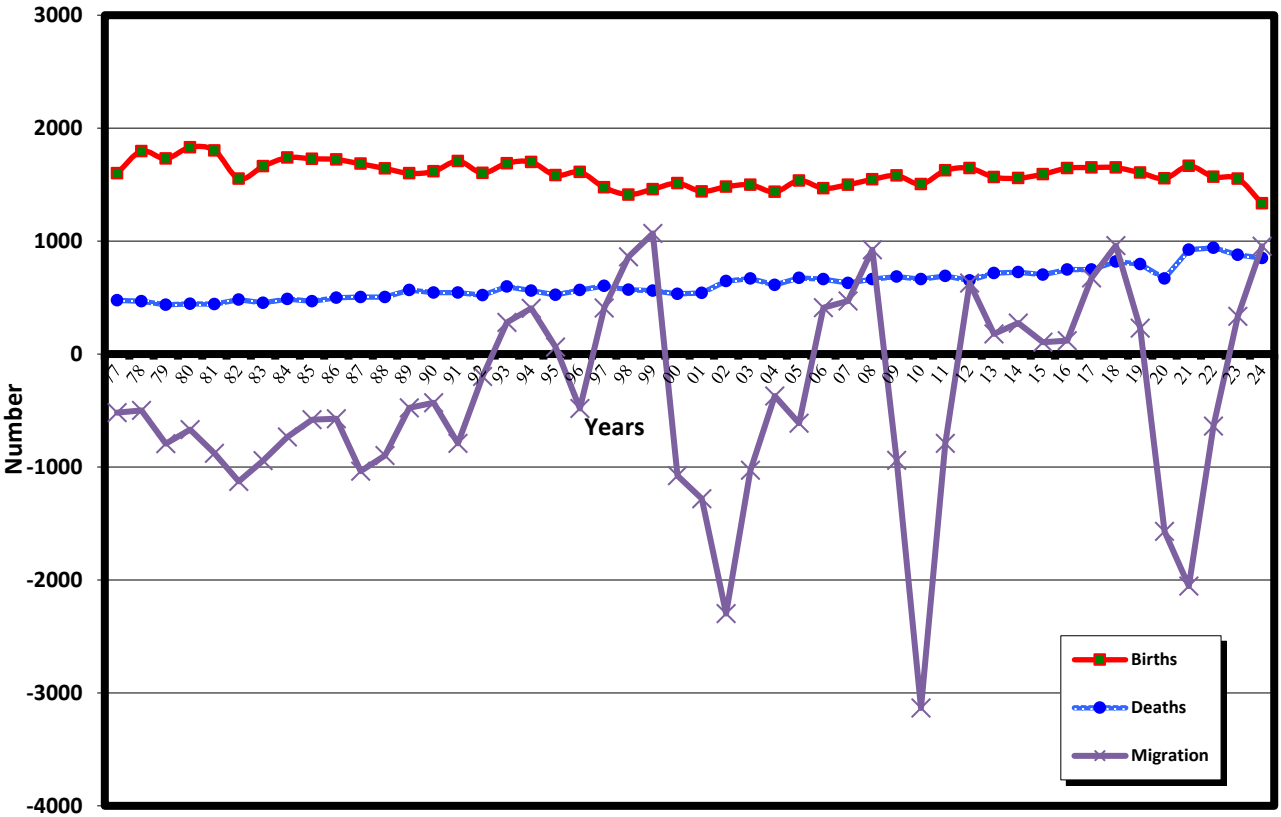

Chart 2: Infant deaths by sex 1976-2024

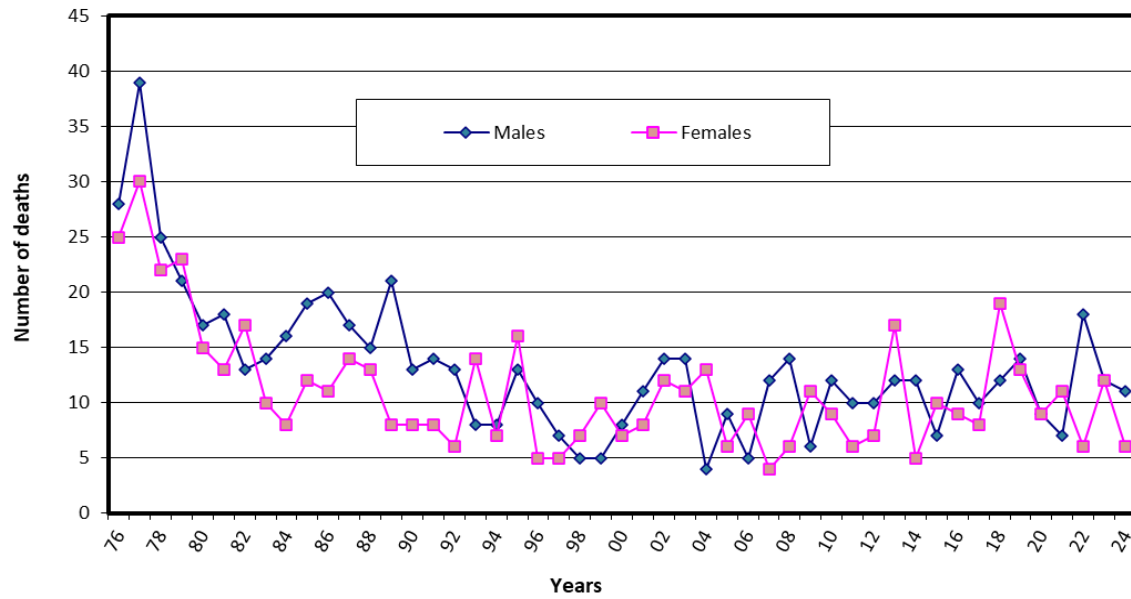


Chart 3: Births out of wedlock, per 1000 live births 1976-2024

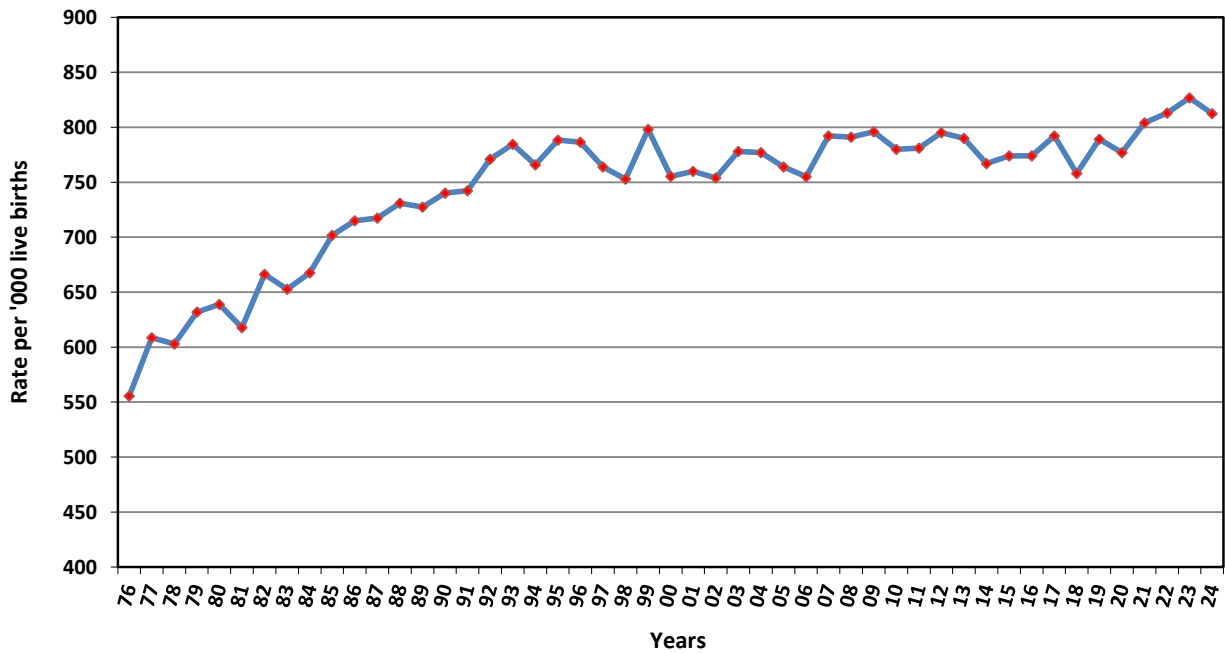


Chart 4a: All Resident Population Age Specific Fertility Rates, 2023-2024

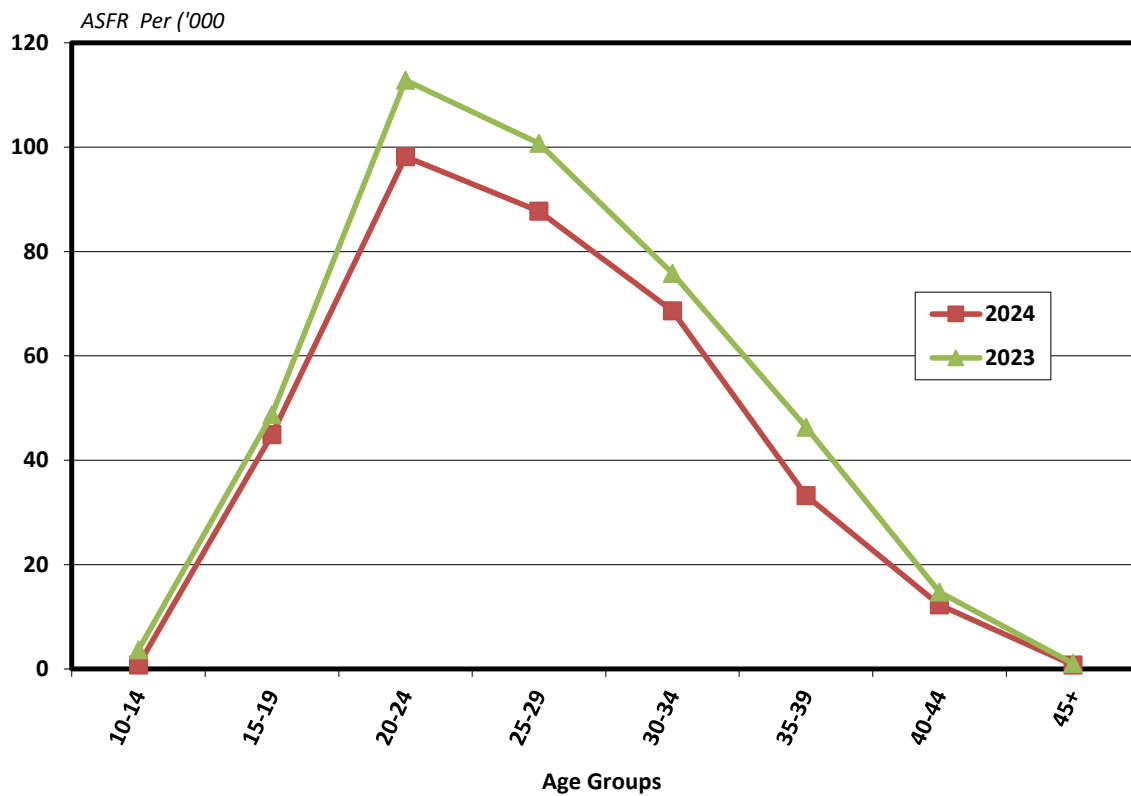


Chart 4b : Seychellois Only Population Age Specific Fertility Rates, 2023-2024

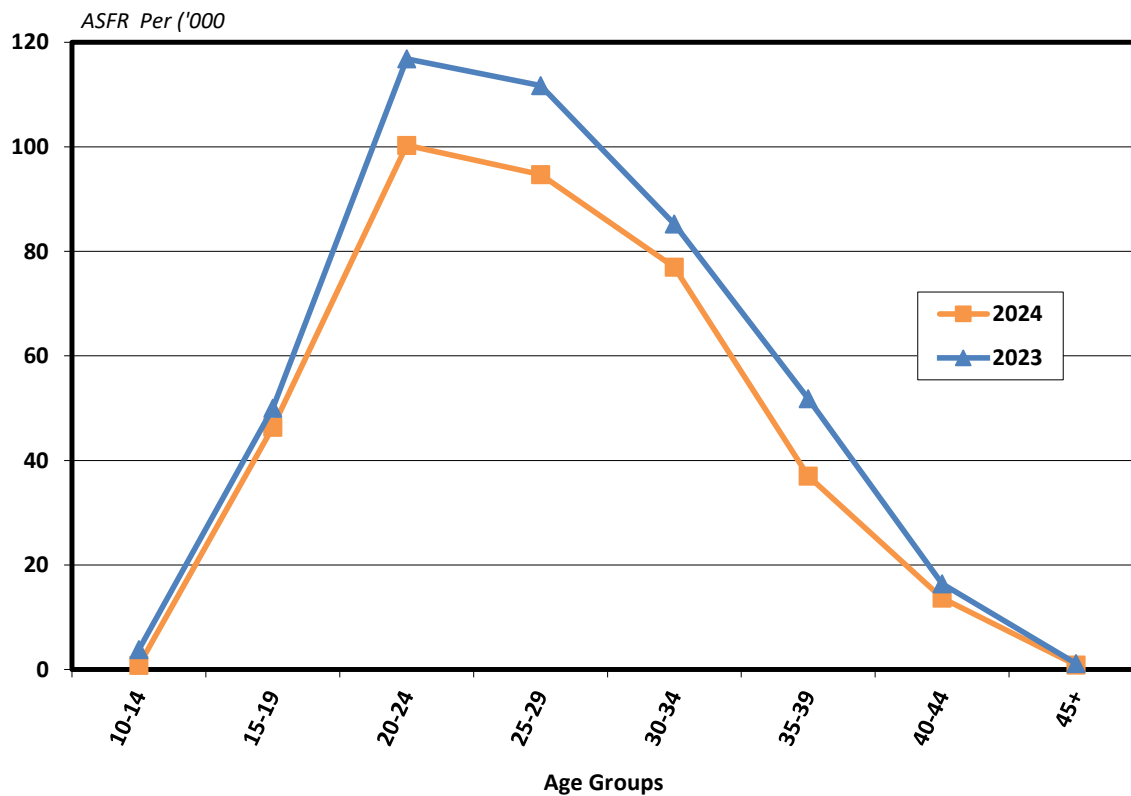


Chart 5: TFR for teenagers, 1998-2024

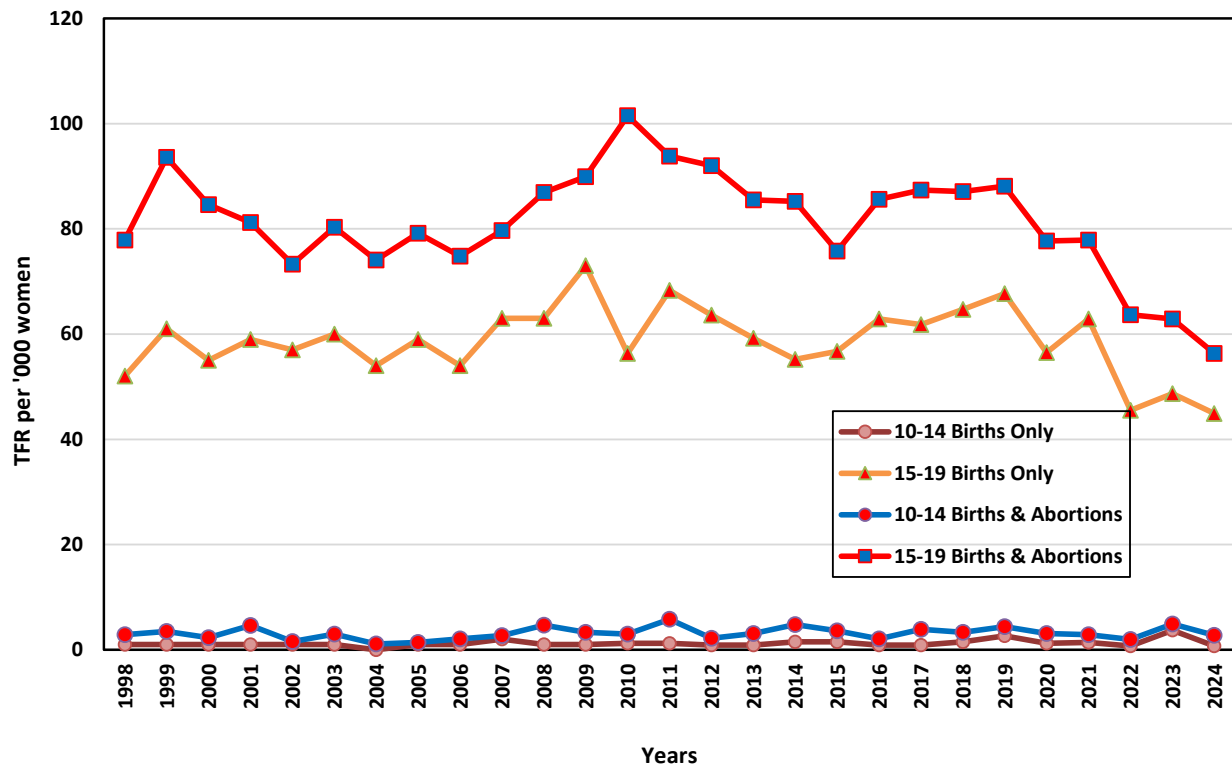


Chart 6a: Number of births and abortions, 2005-2024

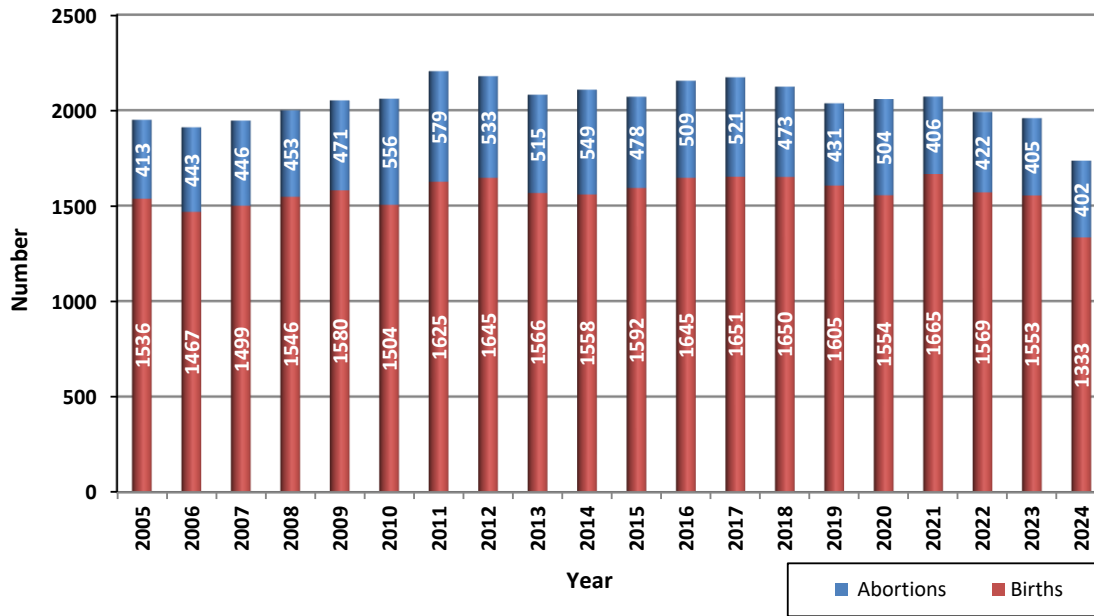


Chart 6b: Percentage of births and abortions out of total live births and registered abortions, 2005-2024

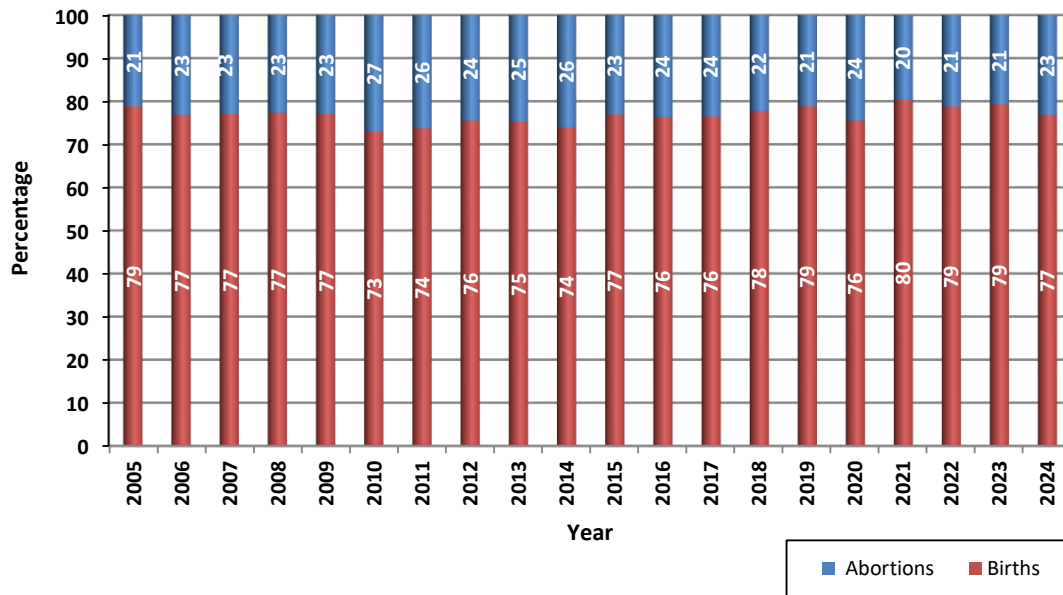


Chart 7a: Percentage of Male deaths, accounted for by selected causes, 2022 - 2024

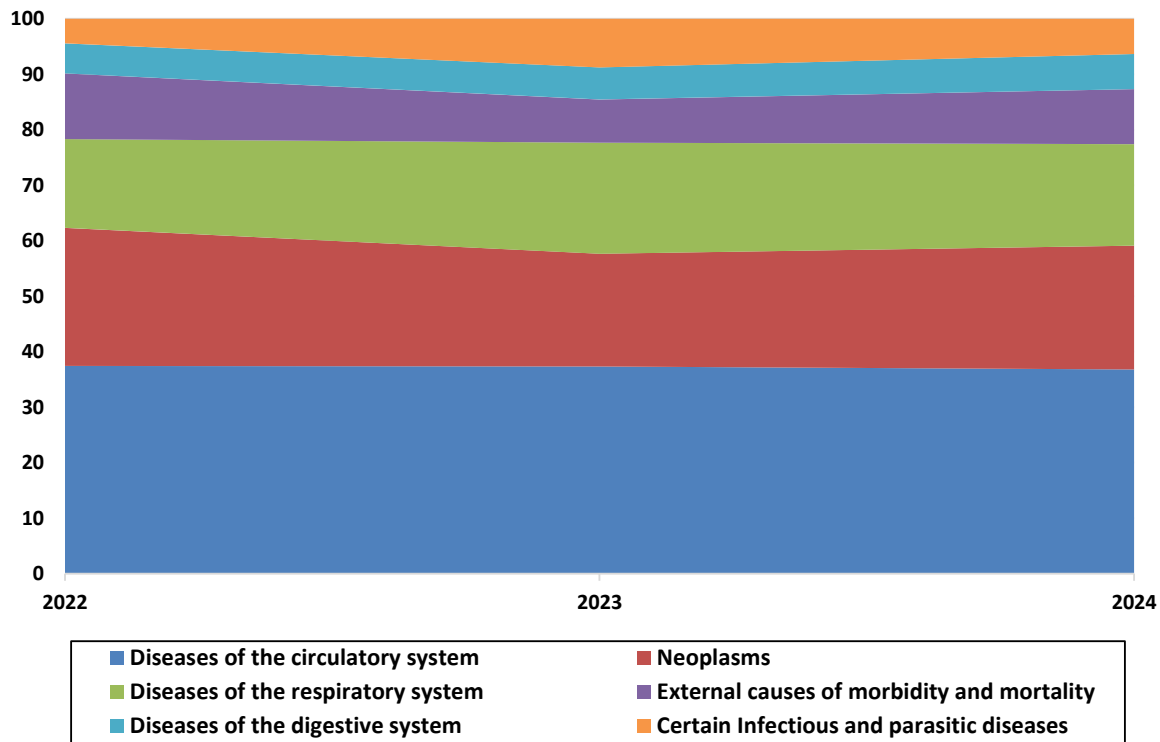


Chart 7b: Percentage of Female deaths, accounted for by selected causes, 2022 - 2024

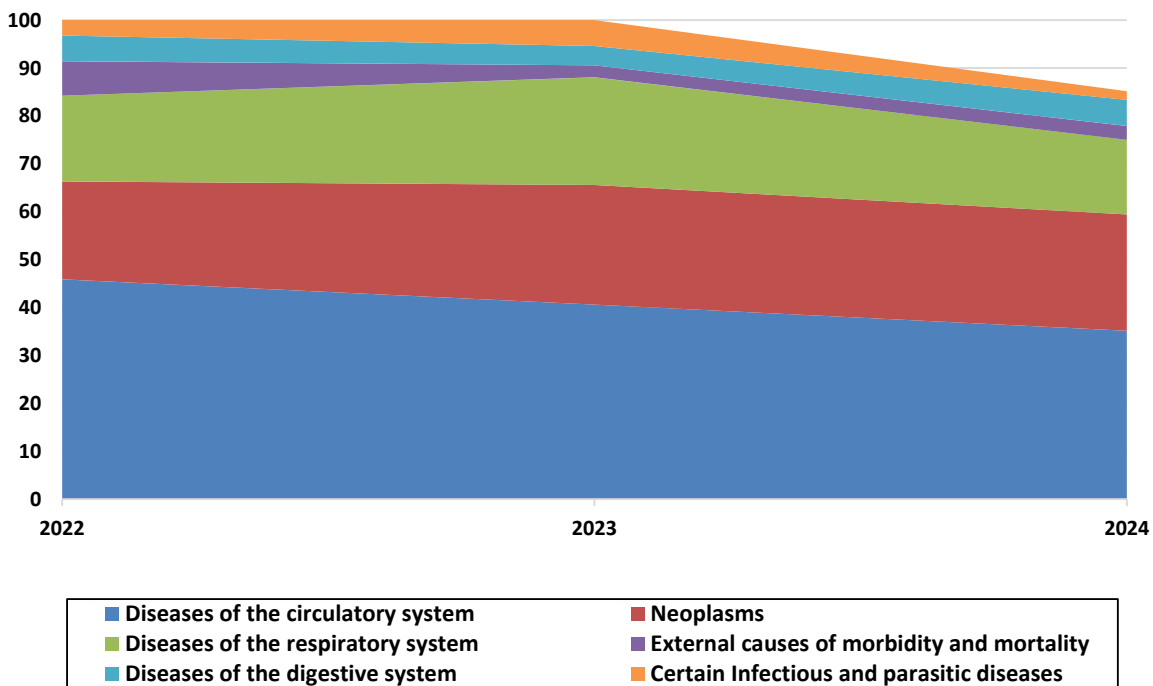


Chart 8a: Deaths to Males aged 5 years or more by selected causes, 2024

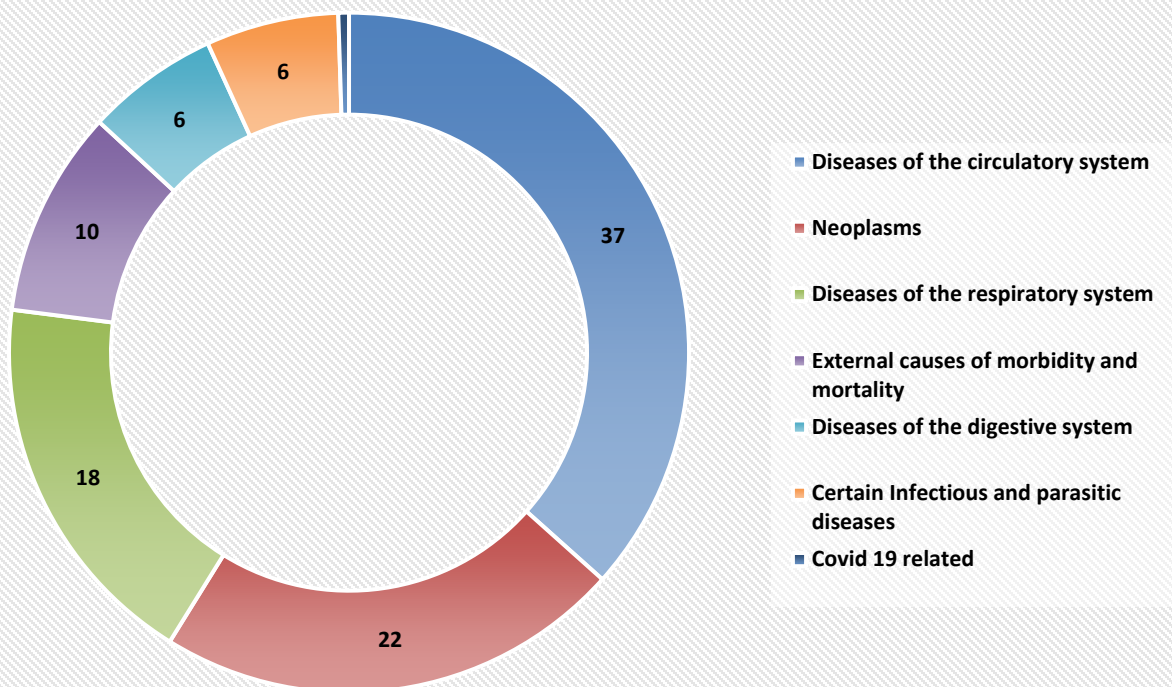


Chart 8b: Deaths to Females aged 5 years or more by selected causes, 2024
